In many cases, this follows when a person loses their driving privileges and must depend upon others for transportation. At times, a senior can feel that they do not need or want to move into an assisted living situation, but their loved ones might have fears for the person's safety when living by themselves.

In assisted living facilities, seniors could choose between private or semi-private. Depending upon the facility and the cost that an individual could afford, they may be housed in a private room or apartment, or they can have a roommate. A lot of facilities are similar in function to college or university residences in that they have private or semi-private rooms, while dining and entertainment areas are common areas inside the building. Other facilities are set up like apartments or condominiums. In either case, they are usually set up with seniors in mind with security, emergency call buttons and intercoms, and proper handrails to keep residents safe. In nearly all facilities, individuals are able to take care of their daily hygienic requirements as well as dress and feed themselves. Services such as laundry, entertainment, cleaning, cooking, social outings, and transportation are normally offered along with providing a safe environment where care can be available in the case of a fall, a medical emergency or accident. Lots of seniors who live on their own are not able to contact someone in the event of an emergency.

In assisted living facilities, residents may not or may need regular nurse visits for administering medications or other medical needs but they are typically free to leave the facility whenever they want. Family members and friends are encouraged to visit often, and other fun amenities like for example walking paths, ponds, gardens, and beauty salons are usually available on the premises.

Most assisted living facilities have a much more pleasant and inviting atmosphere than nursing home facilities while still providing a high quality of care and a safe environment.
